Curative Health Services, Inc, CHS Services, Inc., Hemophilia Access, Inc., Infinity Infusion, LLC, Infinity Infusion II, LLC, Infinity Infusion Care, Ltd., Curative Health Services of New York, Inc., Optimal Care Plus, Inc., MedCare, Inc., Critical Care Systems, Inc., Curative Health Services Co., Curative Health Services III Co., Curative Pharmacy Services, Inc., eBioCare.com, Inc. and Apex Therapeutic Care, Inc. (collectively, “**Curative**”) are soliciting prepetition votes on their proposed Prepackaged Joint Plan of Reorganization Pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (the “**Plan**”), annexed as **Exhibit A** to the accompanying Disclosure Statement, dated February 6, 2006, of Curative (the “**Disclosure Statement**”). This ballot (the “**Master Ballot**”) is to be used by you, as a broker, bank, or other nominee (or as their proxy holder or agent) for beneficial owners (the “**Beneficial Owners**”), as of February 8, 2006 (the “**Voting Record Date**”), of Curative Health Services, Inc.'s 10¾% Senior Notes due 2011 (the “**Senior Notes**”), to transmit the votes of such Beneficial Owners to accept or reject the Plan, which the Plan designates as Class 5 Senior Note Claims, and/or Senior Note Guarantee Claims in Class 12 and/or Class 19 (as such terms are defined in the Plan, and, collectively, the “**Senior Note Claims**”). Capitalized terms used but not defined herein shall have the meaning given to them in the Plan.

Please review carefully the Disclosure Statement (which describes the Plan), the Plan and this Master Ballot before you transmit the votes of the Beneficial Owners to accept or reject the Plan. You may wish to seek legal advice concerning the Plan, as well as concerning the classification and treatment of the Senior Note Claims under the Plan.

Curative has not commenced chapter 11 bankruptcy cases at this time. If Curative receives the necessary acceptances to obtain confirmation of the Plan, it intends to commence chapter 11 cases promptly and to seek prompt confirmation of the Plan by the bankruptcy court. **If the bankruptcy court confirms the Plan, it will be binding on you and your customers, whether or not you vote to accept or reject the Plan.**

THE VOTING DEADLINE IS 5:00 P.M. (NEW YORK CITY TIME), MARCH 13, 2006 (the "Voting Deadline"). You should promptly return the Master Ballot to the Senior Notes Balloting Agent, as specified on the enclosed pre-addressed, postage-paid envelope. If the Senior Notes Balloting Agent does not receive your executed Master Ballot before the Voting Deadline, the vote(s) represented by your Master Ballot will not count. Do not fax this Master Ballot to the Senior Notes Balloting Agent. Master Ballots faxed to the Senior Notes Balloting Agent will not be counted. The Senior Notes Balloting Agent reserves its right, however, to count the votes represented by certain faxed Master Ballots, if any, at the sole discretion of Curative and if circumstances so warrant.

If any Beneficial Owners are listed in Item 5 below as having exercised the New CURE Stock Election, you **MUST** electronically transmit the Senior Notes for such Beneficial Owners by causing DTC to transfer the Senior Notes to a contra cusip to be established by DTC **no later than 5:00 p.m. New York City Time, on March 9, 2006.** See Instruction 11 below for additional information concerning such book entry transfer.

Item 1. Tabulation of Votes with Respect to the Plan.

Please note that whenever a Beneficial Owner casts more than one Beneficial Owner Ballot (as defined below) voting the same Senior Note Claim before the Voting Deadline, the last Beneficial Owner Ballot received before the Voting Deadline will supersede any prior Beneficial Owner Ballots; and each Beneficial Owner must vote all of the Senior Notes owned by such Beneficial Owner either to accept or reject the Plan and may not split its vote. Thus, a Beneficial Owner Ballot that partially rejects and partially accepts the Plan will not be counted.
